The Suncor Energy Foundation (SEF) embodies Suncor's purpose of caring for each other and the Earth by connecting business and community strengths to make a positive difference in society. Through partnerships and relationships with those who are courageously seeking solutions, we help spark change and propel progress for generations ahead. SEF is a private, charitable foundation established by Suncor in 1998. Since its inception more than \$260 million has been contributed by SEF to charitable organizations across Canada.

In 2022, SEF donated \$17.8M to community

SEF combines community and Suncor strengths to find social, economic and environmental solutions to complex challenges. To bring this work to life, SEF focuses on three interconnected pillars:

Community presence

We invest in communities where our employees work and live, through donations and sponsorships to local community organizations. We also support employee investments in causes that matter to them through the SunCares program.

In 2022, SEF contributed \$2.8 million through the SunCares program.

Funding priorities

Through our donation partnerships, we are learning from and with **Indigenous Peoples** and others to strengthen **community** while the world is going through an energy transition.

Social innovation capacity

We contribute to the development of the social innovation sector and use social innovation practices to develop our own programs. We define social innovation as any initiative, product, process, program or design that challenges or changes society's actions and beliefs. Successful social innovations create long-term transformative impact.

In 2022, SEF donated more than \$13.9 million to community through its funding priorities pillar.
