In 2022, Suncor made contributions totalling **\$40M** in value⁴

Suncor Energy Foundation

\$24M donated to SEF. SEF embodies Suncor's purpose of caring for each other and the Earth by working directly with communities seeking solutions to challenges today and for generations ahead.

Syncrude

\$2.5M donated through Syncrude. Syncrude has helped support essential community services and initiatives for decades in the Regional Municipality of Wood Buffalo and beyond.

Petro-Canada CareMakers Foundation™

\$2M donated to PCCF. PCCF creates awareness about family caregiving in Canada, and inspires Canadians to help by raising funds to enable and amplify the work of Canadian charitable organizations that support caregiving.

Cash and in-kind

\$11.8M donated to community through various cash and in-kind contributions.
